



## Controlled Substances Guidelines

### **PAIN MANAGEMENT:**

Patients who are under pain management care, and have been prescribed opioid medications, are required to follow-up in one month intervals, along with pill counts, and lab work, as required by the physician. **NO** medication will be prescribed, if patient misses their monthly appointment. If patient is non-compliant with these guidelines, this will result of no further medication being prescribed, referral to a detox program, and dismissal from the practice.

### **ATTENTION DEFICIT DISORDER:**

Patients (both adults and children) who have been prescribed medication for attention deficit disorder, **MUST** schedule appointments **EVERY FOUR MONTHS**, along with lab work if necessary. The office must be notified of any adverse reactions immediately upon administering of medication. Failure to adhere to these guidelines, will result in no further medication being prescribed. A follow-up appointment must be scheduled. If three missed appointments are missed within this period, no further medication will be prescribed, and patient will be dismissed from the practice.
